

Invocation

(we make the sign of the cross, touching forehead, heart, and shoulders) Into your loving hands

#### Baptism — The Way of Faith

The Creator wants to save all of his creation from Civilization.

✤ So the Creator is calling me to let go of the Way of Civilization and become a lifelong disciple who follows the Way of Jesus.

But breaking free from your addictions to the Way of Civilization is scary, painful, and difficult to imagine.

✤ It means the death and rebirth of my entire self and life.

Only the Creator can accomplish this through his sacraments.

✤ In the sacrament of Baptism, which begins with water and his word, the Creator immerses me into his story and life.

Through his lifelong work of Baptism, the Creator

★ daily destroys my old life in the Way of Civilization, forgives and releases me from it, and resurrects me into a new life on the Way of Jesus.

The Creator is rebuilding your life around Jesus-centered habits, patterns, and disciplines.

✤ I receive the Creator's work of Baptism through Faith.

I Lord, baptize us and wash away our sin. Lord, baptize us and change our hearts within. Lord, baptize us and grow our discipline. Lord, we praise you, for all that you do!
