Seal 7, Trumpet 7, Sign 7: The Seven Plagues of the Creator's Anger

Then I saw another sign in Heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels having the seven last plagues through which the Creator's passion was completed (Exod 12:13; Lev 26:14-21; Deut 28:58-61; Rev 10:7, 14:10, 14:19). I saw something like a glass sea—*peace and calm*—mingled with fire—*the Creator's Word* (Rev 3:18, 4:5-6, 8:5, 8:7). Those who had been victorious over the *Nation*, its *Politician*, and *Money*, had been standing upon the glass sea holding harps from the Creator (Rev 5:8, 12:1, 14:2). They sang the song of Moses, who was the Creator's servant, and the song of the Lamb (Exod 15:1-18; Deut 31:30—32:43). They were saying,

"Lord, the All-Powerful Creator, your practices are great and marvelous (Psa 8:1-9, 139:14)! Ruler of the ethnic-groups, your ways are righteous and truthful (Psa 111:1-10)! ⁴ Lord, who will not be afraid and glorify your name (Jer 10:7; Mal 1:11; Rev 11:13)? You alone are good! All the ethnic-groups will come and bow down before you (Psa 22:27; Isa 45:23; Zech 14:16; Rev 4:10, 9:20, 14:7)! Your righteous practices have been made visible (Psa 19:1-4, 86:8-10; Rev 6:10)!"

⁵ After this I looked and the temple, which is the dwelling-place of the Martyrdom, was open in Heaven (Psa 27:5; Rev 3:12, 7:15, 11:1, 11:19, 13:6, 14:15). ⁶ The seven angels having the seven plagues came out from the temple wearing pure, bright cloth and gold belts wrapped around their chests—*dressed like priests offering forgiveness* (Exod 28:1-8; Rev 1:13). ⁷ One of the four creatures gave the seven angels the seven gold bowls filled with the passion of the Creator, the one who lives into the ages of the ages (Jer 25:15; Rev 1:18, 4:6-8, 5:13, 7:12, 10:6). ⁸ The temple was filled with the smoke of the Creator's glory and power (Exod 19:18, 40:34-35; 1 Kgs 8:10-11; Isa 6:4; Rev 3:12, 7:15, 11:1, 11:19, 13:6, 14:15). No one was able to enter into the temple until the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed (Exod 33:17-23; Lev 16:2; Rev 10:7, 15:1). ^{16.1} Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels,

"Go! Pour out the seven bowls of the Creator's passion throughout the Earth (Psa 79:1-7; Jer 10:25; Ezek 22:23-31; Zeph 3:8-9; Rev 8:7)!"

Plague 1: Diseases on the Unfaithful of the Earth

² The first angel went and poured out his bowl throughout the Earth—*the material realm*—and harmful and destructive diseases came upon the humans who had the *Nation's* brand—*Money*—and bowed down to its *Politician* (Exod 9:8-17; Deut 28:27-37; Rev 9:20, 13:12-17, 14:9-11).

Plague 2: Blood of Violence in the Sea

³ The second angel poured out his bowl into the Sea—*the chaotic realm*—and it became like the blood of a corpse—*filled with violence*—and every living soul in the Sea died (2 Kgs 3:21-23; Isa 34:2-3; Hos 4:1-3; Rev 8:8-9, 11:6).

Plague 3: Blood of Violence in the Rivers

⁴ The third angel poured out his bowl into the Rivers and Water Springs—*the sources of life*—and they became blood—*filled with violence* (Exod 7:14-25; Rev 8:10-11, 9:14, 12:15-16). ⁵ I heard the angel of the waters say,

"The one who is and was, you are righteous for these judgments (Psa 145:17; Rev 1:4-5, 1:8, 4:8, 11:17-18, 14:7)! ⁶ For they have poured out the blood of the saints and prophets *in violence* (Gen 4:9-11, 9:4-6; 2 Kgs 24:4; Rev 6:10-11, 11:18) and you have given them blood—*violence*—to drink (Psa 78:44; Isa 26:21, 49:25-26; Ezek 24:6-8; Wis 11:15; Rev 14:8-10)! They deserve it!"

⁷ I heard the altar (Rev 6:9, 8:3, 9:13, 11:1, 14:18) saying,

"Lord, the All-Powerful Creator, your judgments are truthful and righteous (Rev 15:3)!"

Plague 4: Fire of the Creator's Word from the Heavens

⁸ The fourth angel poured out his bowl upon the sun—*the spiritual powers and authorities*—and it was allowed to scorch humanity with fire—*the Creator's Word* (Psa 121:5-6; Isa 49:10; Jon 4:8; Rev 7:16, 8:12, 9:2). ⁹ Humanity was scorched with great heat and they blasphemed the name of the Creator who had authority over these plagues (2 Kgs 6:24-33; Rev 2:9, 13:5-6). But they did not repent and give him glory (Rev 2:21, 9:20-21, 11:13).

Plague 5: The Nation's Kingdom Is Darkened

¹⁰ The fifth angel poured out his bowl upon the throne of the *Nation* and his kingdom became dark—*lawless* (Exod 10:21-29; Isa 5:18-30, 8:19-22; Exek 32:7-8; Amos 5:18-20; Rev 2:13, 13:2). They began to bite their tongues because of the pain (Job 29:9-10; Rev 13:5, 13:11, 13:15). ¹¹ They blasphemed the Creator of Heaven because of their pains and diseases, but they did not repent of their practices (Rev 16:9).

Plague 6: All Rulers Gather for War

- The sixth angel poured out his bowl upon the Great Euphrates River—the birthplace of Civilization (Isa 11:11-16; Rev 8:10-11, 9:14, 12:15-16, 16:4). Its water dried up to prepare the way for the rulers from the east (Isa 44:24-28; Jer 50:35-38, 51:36-40). ¹³ I saw three unclean spirits—teachings—like frogs—which change their form—coming out of the mouths of *Satan*, the *Nation*, and the False Prophet—the *Government* (Exod 8:1-15; 1 Kgs 22:15-40; Isa 9:15-16; Zech 13:2; Rev 9:17-19, 12:15-16, 13:5-6). ¹⁴ For they are demonic spirits making signs (Rev 13:13-14) that go out to gather the rulers of all the civilized-world for the war of the Great Day of the All-Powerful Creator (Isa 13:6-9; Ezek 13:1-5, 30:1-4; Joel 3:9-14; Obad 1:15-17; Zeph 1:1-18; Rev 9:7-9).
 - ¹⁵ "Look! I am arriving like a thief! Blessed is the one who stays awake and clings to his garments so that he does not walk around naked and ashamed (Isa 47:1-3; Rev 3:2-3, 3:18, 14:4)!"
- ¹⁶ The rulers gathered at the place which in Hebrew is called Mount-Megiddo—*to war against themselves and kill the Creator's Christ* (2 Kgs 9:6-27, 23:1-30; Zech 12:10-14).
